Serving Dinner at Hangar 17 - April 22

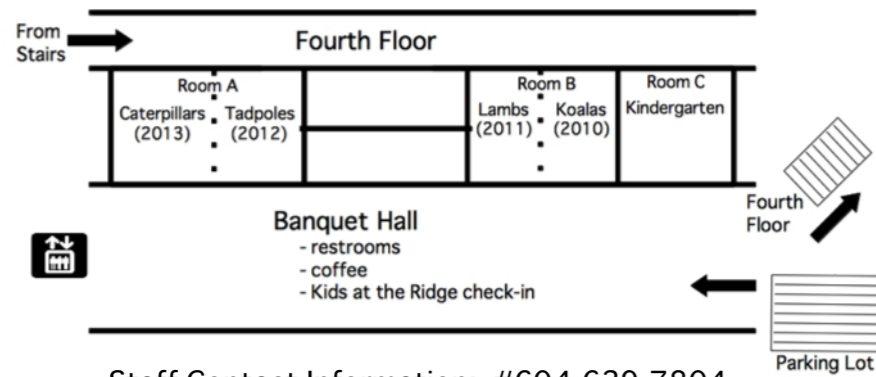

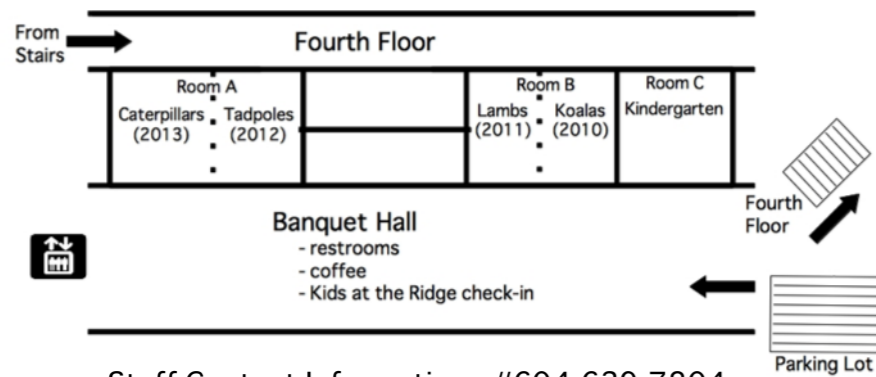
