Hosting Summer Camp Leaders

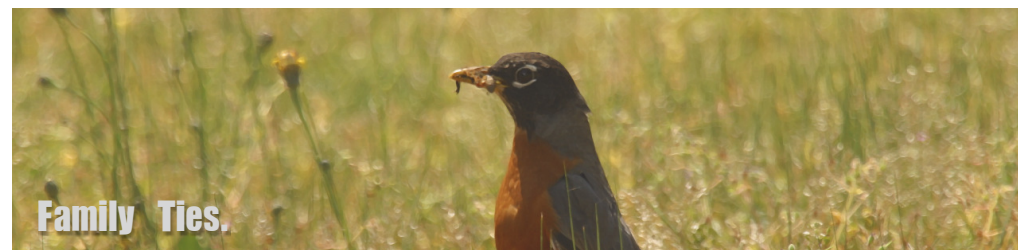
