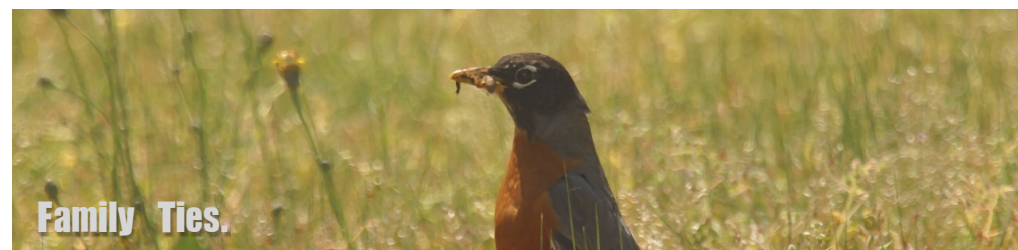

### Summer Sunday Cinema

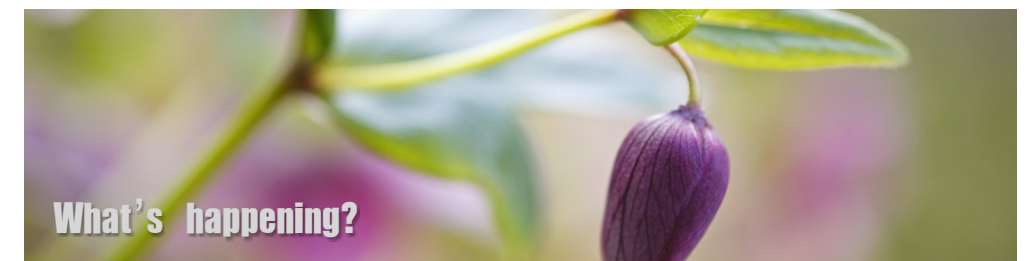
