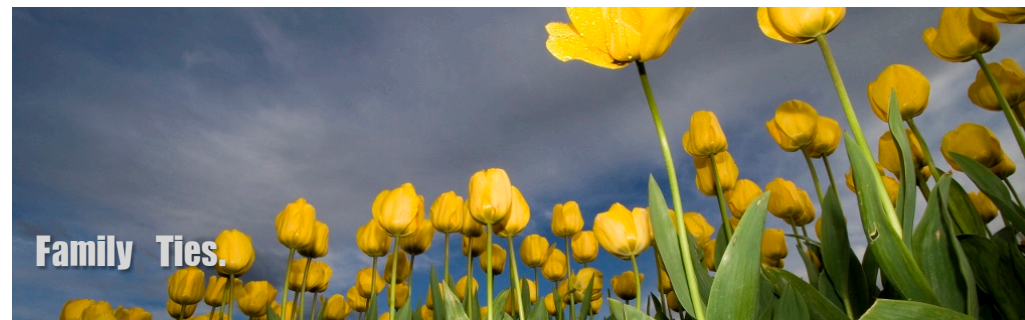

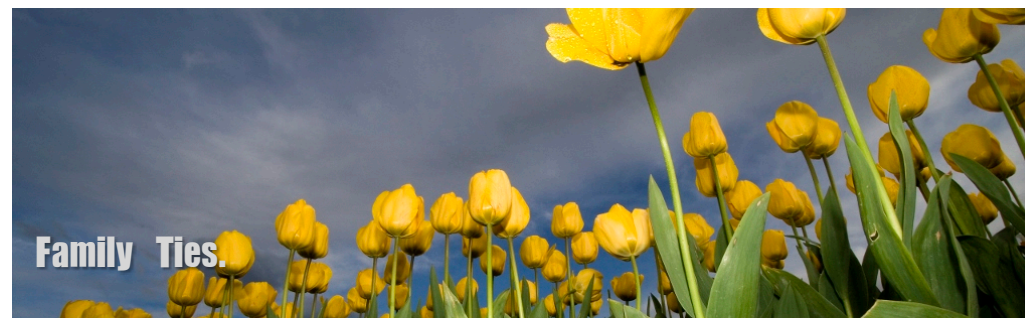

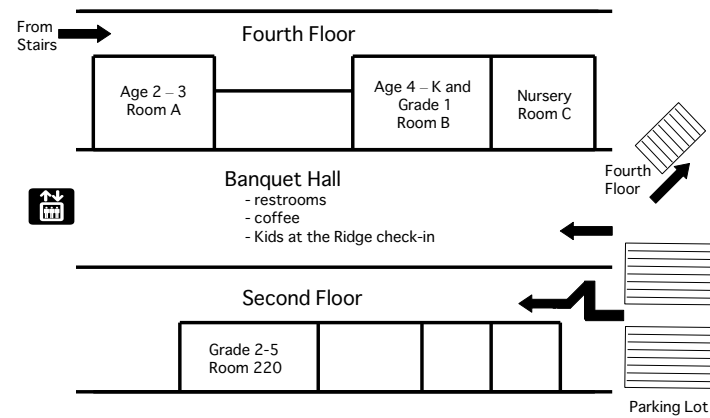
### A Man's Breakfast

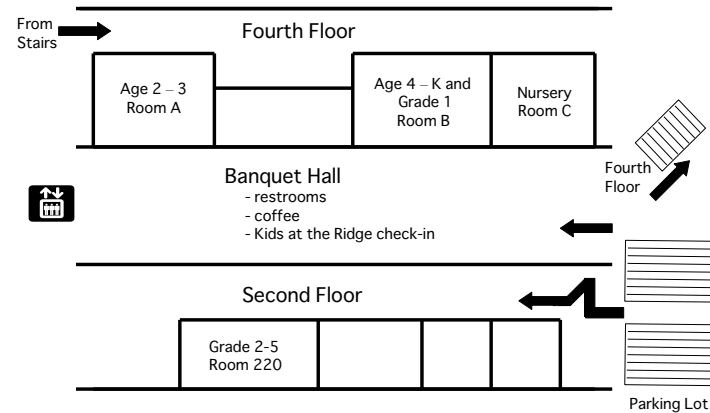
